The core team member must hold an advanced graduate degree (Masters / PhD) in Social Sciences/Urban Planning and have had at least 2 years of work experience in quantitative analysis of economic, demographic or other data. Experience working with Indian datasets such as the Census, NSS, NFHS, and other large-scale sources of socio-economic information is a strong plus.
